## The application process



**STAGE 1**  
First, you'll complete an application online, giving details of your work experience, qualifications, key skills and hobbies and any training you've done. This is where you'll tell us why you're interested in an apprenticeship programme.



**STAGE 2**  
Next you'll take an online ability test. If you pass the benchmark you will progress to the next stage of the process.



**STAGE 3**  
All candidates who reach the final stage of the selection process will be invited to an assessment centre for a half-day event that includes a competency-based interview, a group exercise and a presentation.
